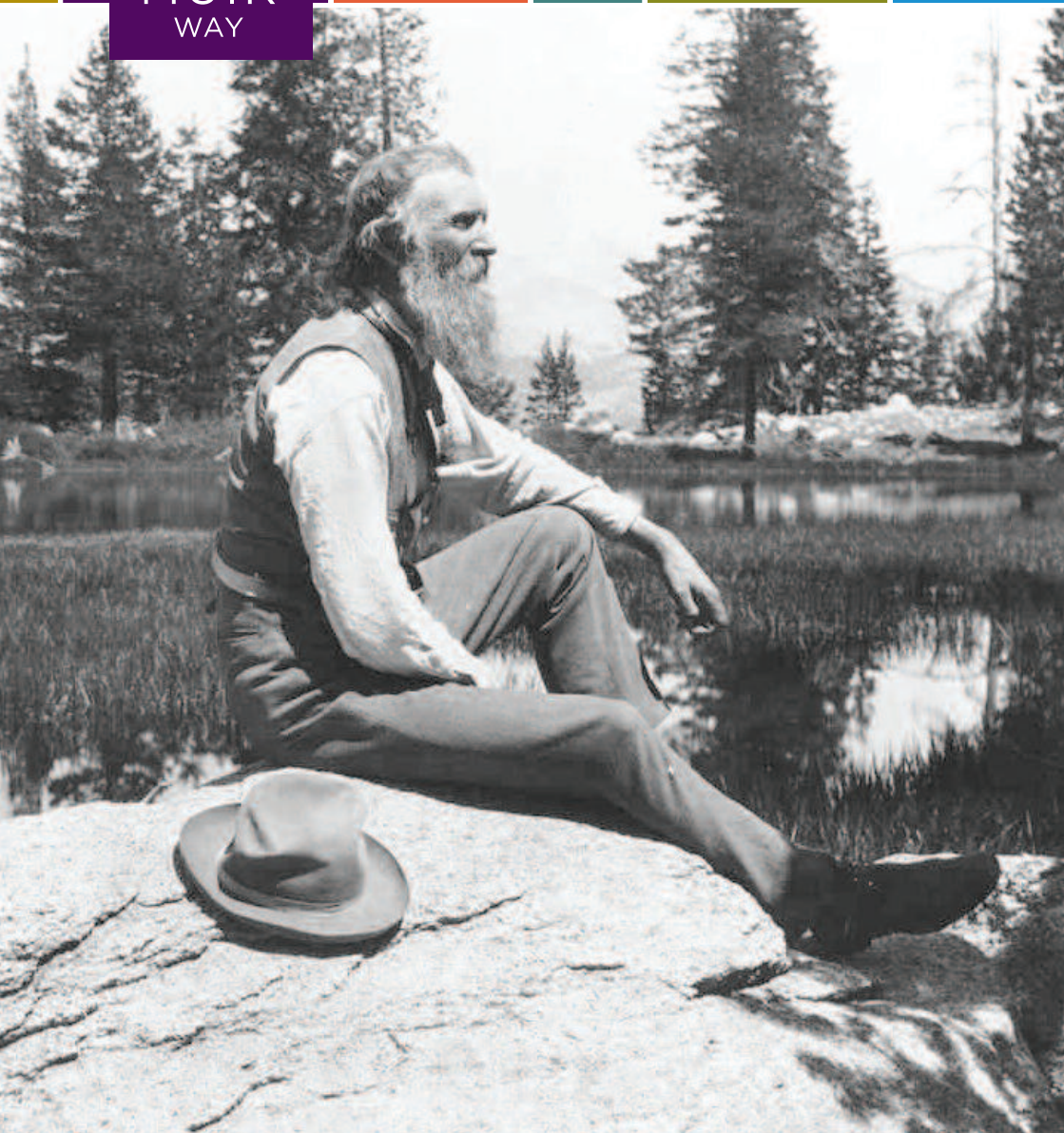

The John Muir Festival, 17 - 26 April 2014 marks the official opening of Scotland's new national pathway, the John Muir Way, which stretches from Dunbar, Muir's birthplace to Helensburgh. The festival is a celebration of Muir's life and work and comprises large scale national events alongside local projects and initiatives. Born in 1838 in Dunbar, East Lothian, John Muir emigrated to the US in 1849. Recognised as the 'father of modern conservation', the founder of America's national parks and a campaigning environmentalist, Muir helped change the way we look at nature and how we consider the world's natural resources.
