

## CHAIRMAN'S REPORT - NOVEMBER 2025

I'd like to give you a brief account of the Committee's activities since our last AGM.

IN DECEMBER we held our CAROL CONCERT at the Museum with the BO'NESS BELLES.

IN JANUARY we didn't hold the James Watt Supper in the Corbie Inn as we were too involved with trying to save the Museum.

IN MARCH we held our belated JAMES WATT SUPPER with the BELLES providing entertainment. We also provided craft activities for children in the Museum in support of the SILENT FILM FESTIVAL.

IN APRIL we provided children's activities in the Museum when the house was open for EASTER. Once again, two of us and Daniel, our young volunteer, acted as stewards for the Forth Ultra Team Event Marathon. The HIDDEN HERITAGE project has continued to be pursued with our Vice-Chair Jane putting in a lot of hard work. She said last year that we hoped it would be completed in 2025 but sadly this is not the case. Together with the Council, we are making slow progress on what has been a long and frustrating process.

DURING THE YEAR, among other activities, committee members attended meetings and conferences. Talks were given by Ian and GUIDED WALKS offered throughout the year.
